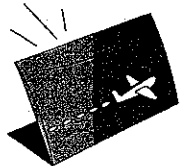

SERIOUS ACCIDENT EMERGENCY TRAVEL BENEFIT

A SERIOUS CONSIDERATION

The majority of our members take advantage of our Serious Accident Emergency Travel Benefit, and wisely so. Make sure you know what it is all about, and have nominated the persons you care about most.



What's it all about?

Our Serious Accident Emergency Travel Benefit means that should you or your nominated overseas person meet with an accident that causes serious injury or death, the Association provides a ticket to get you to them, or vice versa up to the value of £1,500.

What is the definition of "accident"?

Serious bodily injury, or death, caused by accidental violent external or visible means. In the event of injury the patient must be on the dangerously ill list.

Are there exclusions?

YES, but only a few. In a nutshell these are suicide, mountaineering, pot holing and racing of any kind. In addition taking part in any rebellion or riot and any consequence of war would not be covered. Similarly voluntary plastic or cosmetic surgery and any incidence as a result of radioactivity are excluded. The age limit on this benefit is 75 years.

What happens if I meet with an accident?

The Serious Accident Emergency Travel Benefit is vice versa, so if you were seriously injured or died as a result of an accident, your nominee would be flown to the U.K.

What proof do I have that this benefit has been taken out?

Once you have joined the Association or renewed your membership we send you full details of all the persons nominated, as well as the dates applicable and details of the benefit. You should carefully check this document to ensure details are correct.

What do I do in the event of an accident?

You should immediately (or up to a maximum of seven days of the accident) contact our office in Staines. You must at the time be able to provide us with the name and telephone number of the doctor or hospital to be contacted. Before we are able to release a ticket it will be necessary for us to make suitable enquiries to establish the validity.

What is the value of the ticket?

The Friendship Association will provide a ticket up to a maximum value of £1,500.

Can I travel and claim on my return?

YES, provided you have advised us of the emergency

before you leave, and provided you bring back the relevant proof from the hospital or doctor.

How quickly can you get me on a flight?

From the moment you advise us of the accident we will start arranging to get you on the first available flight. At peak times it may be difficult to get low cost seats, but every effort will be made to get you away soonest. Remember, however, that we cannot assist if passports have expired, so make sure you are always up to date.

How long does the protection last?

The Serious Accident Emergency Travel Benefit is valid for the duration of your membership. You will receive written confirmation from us stating all the names involved and the date the benefit is valid to.

Is my spouse covered as well?

Not automatically, but you can nominate additional partners both here and overseas on payment of a small additional fee per nominated person.

Can I nominate a relative Overseas?

YES, you can nominate relatives in South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and the USA.

Do you advise my overseas nominee about this benefit?

NO, the onus is on you to ensure all nominated persons are aware of the Serious Accident Emergency Travel Benefit. It may be sensible to give them a copy of your certificate so that they know the procedure and scope of the cover.

What happens if we need to get someone to the U.K. in an emergency?

With the assistance of our sister association, Friends of the Lion, we can get family here in no time at all. Tickets can be made available for collection at the closest airport, provided all the formalities have been concluded.

I have nominated my daughter, what happens if her husband has the accident?

Sadly you would not be eligible for a ticket even though your daughter would really need you at the time. It is important to make sure you cover sons and daughters in law as well. Remember you are only covered to visit the person whose name appears next to yours.

Don't say it can't happen to me. We are often saddened when tragedies occur and no benefit is in place. We know that whilst the Free Emergency flight in no way lessens the grief, it does help to remove the financial strain tragedy can bring.
